We hope you all had a nice Easter break and are ready for a busy summer term.

The topics for this term are:

- Rec - Water – How water is used and where it is found in the world.
- Year 1 - Science - growing plants – going onto naming, recognising and labelling the different parts of plants, fruit and vegetables as well as flowers.
Geography – simple map work introducing using simple directions.
- Year 2 - Science – Electricity, looking at what uses electricity, the dangers of electricity and making electrical circuits.
Geography – The seaside – looking at the different features of a seaside and why people like to go to one.
